It is affiliated to Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati, recognized by AICTE (All India Council for Technical Education), New Delhi and approved by DTE (Directorate of Technical Education), Maharashtra State, Mumbai. It is conducting 5 Undergraduate Engineering courses and 5 Postgraduate (4 Engineering and 1 Management) Courses and SGIARC - TBI Foundation having its premises and campus at Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Khangaon Road, Shegaon District Buldhana, Maharashtra State, India represented by its Principal, Prof. (DR.) **S. B. SOMANI** herein referred to as **SECOND PARTY**

Both Universities (LPU, Laguna and SSGMCE) as above have expressed a desire of entering into a Memorandum of Agreement to meet their respective objectives, which are set out herein below.

1. The purpose of this MOA is to develop academic and educational cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the two Universities (parties).

2. Presently Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Shegaon is offering **Four Year (Full Time) B.E.** Undergraduate Engineering courses in Electrical (Electronics and Power), Electronics and Telecommunication, Computer Science, Mechanical and Information Technology.

It also offers **Two Year (Full Time) M.B.A Course** and **M.E.** Post Graduate Engineering courses are offered in Electrical Power System, Digital Electronics, Computer Engineering, Advanced Manufacturing and Mechanical Systems Design.

SHRI GAJANAN INNOVATION AND ADVANCED RESEARCH CENTRE (SGIARC)-TBI FOUNDATION – A centre of excellence for Techno Business Incubation facilitating the complete Business Ecosystem.

3. Presently LPU-Laguna offers the following programs:

4. LPU, Laguna and SSGMCE, Shegaon agrees to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

5. Both, the LPU, Laguna and SSGMCE, Shegaon initially identified following areas where both the Universities (parties) may start collaboration efforts, these are as:

6. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MOA will be separately negotiated through Ed Value Chain solution and agreed between colleges, schools or institutes which carry out the specific projects and will be subject to a separate written agreement. Each University (Party) agrees to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries after full consultation and approval.

7. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in Clause 4 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Universities (Parties) concerned.

8. Both Universities (Both, the LPU, Laguna and SSGMCE, Shegaon) agree that prior written approval is required before using the other University's / College's name, logo, or other Intellectual Property rights in any advertising or associated publicity.

9. There should be the collaborative research activities under this MOA and if they result in any potential for intellectual property, each University (Party) shall seek an equitable and fair agreement as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.

10. This MOA may only be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of each party.

11. This MOA is valid for a period of five years initially from the date of signing by the authorized signatories of each University (Parties). Each University (Parties) shall review the status of the MOA at least six months before the end of the five-year period to determine whether it wishes the MOA to continue and, if so, any modifications that might be necessary. The period of validity of this MOA may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both universities and Ed Value Chain Solution Pvt. Ltd.

12. This MOA may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the (Parties) Universities/ Ed Value upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than Six months before the termination date through Ed value Chain Solution Pvt., Ltd.

13. Both the parties will correspond through Ed value Chain solution Pvt. Ltd. and will keep in loop of all affairs with consent. Any sort of financial dealings in any manner-likewise of course fee, exchange programme fee, if any has to be with Ed Value only. All financials from either of the party will be quoted by Ed Value, no direct offer will be made.

14. A tri party joint committee will be made to look into regular correspondence and affairs.

15. The (Parties) Universities may disclose certain confidential information to the other in relation to any future proposal made under this MOA. Each (Party)University, therefore agrees that the contents of this MOA and the negotiations in relation to any future proposal remain strictly confidential and each (Party) University hereby undertakes not to disclose the same to any third (Institute) University, save for its professional advisers, without the prior written consent of the other (Party) University except where such disclosure is required by Law (including, without limitation, under applicable freedom of information Legislation).

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

a. **Governing Law.** This Agreement shall be governed by, and interpreted in accordance with, the laws of the Philippines and India.

b. **Venue of Suit.** Any legal action, suit, or proceeding arising out of, or relating to, this Agreement shall be brought or instituted in the appropriate courts of Batangas City, Shegaon City and the Parties hereby irrevocably submit themselves to the jurisdiction of such courts.

c. **Severability.** If any one of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect under any applicable law, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not in any way be affected or impaired.

d. **Assignability.** This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall be to the Benefit of the Parties and their respective successors and permitted assigns, if any, but neither this Agreement nor any rights hereunder shall be assigned directly or indirectly by the SECOND PARTY without the prior written consent of the FIRST PARTY, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.

e. **Headings.** The headings or sections and paragraphs used in this Agreement are inserted for the convenience of reference only and shall not affect the interpretation of the respective sections and paragraphs of this Agreement.

f. **Agency, Partnership and Joint Venture Excluded.** Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as establishing or implying any partnership, joint venture or employer -employee relationship between the Parties thereto.

g. **No Waiver.** The failure of a party to insist upon a strict performance of any of the terms, conditions, and covenants thereof, or to exercise any option herein contained, shall not be deemed a relinquishment or waiver of any right or remedy that the Party may have nor shall it be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach or default of the terms, conditions, and covenants herein contained, which conditions and covenants shall continue to be in full force and effect, unless expressed in writing and signed by the Party.

h. Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Shegaon, (SSGMCE) values the privacy and security of personal data entrusted by its stakeholders for legitimate purposes. SSGMCE intends to comply with the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (DPA) and cooperate fully with the National Privacy Commission (NPC). SSGMCE recognizes its responsibilities with respect to the data they collect, record, organize, update, use, consolidate or destruct from stakeholders. The personal data obtained from this project will be entered and stored within authorized information and communication system/s and will only be accessed by authorized personnel/s. SSGMCE will institute appropriate organizational, technical, and physical security measures to ensure the protection of personal data.
