INCUBATION AGREEMENT

This Incubation Agreement (Agreement) is being executed in Shegaon, Maharashtra on
this 03/07/2023 (Effective Date), by and between:

- (1) M/S ApexaIQ Technologies Pvt Ltd (CINU72900DL2022FTC406916), a company incorporated and registered under the provisions of Indian laws, and having its registered office at F 78 Venus Appt. Sector 9 Rohini Near Japanese Park Delhi-110085 (hereinafter referred to as **Incubatee**, which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its administrators and successors in interest);

AND

- (2) **Shri Gajanan Innovation and Advance Research Centre (SGIARC)-TBI Foundation, Shegaon**, a company incorporated and registered under section 8 under the provisions of Indian laws, having its registered office at Shegaon, in Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering Campus, Shegaon (hereinafter referred to as **(SGIARC-TBI)**, which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its administrators, successors in interest).

Incubatee and SGIARC-TBI shall hereinafter individually be referred to as the **Party** and collectively as the **Parties**.

WHEREAS

- (A) The Incubatee is in the business of Software product development. Apexa iQ is a Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) platform that provides a comprehensive view of your entire IT infrastructure through a single dashboard.
- (B) **SGIARC-TBI** is a business incubator supported by Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Shegaon, that helps the Incubatees to overall growth including the office space for a specified period of time;
- (C) The Incubatee desires to retain the Services (as provided under Clause 1) of SGIARC-TBI, and the Incubatee has approached SGIARC-TBI for the facilitation of such coordination between SGIARC-TBI and the Incubatee, to which SGIARC-TBI has agreed; and
- (D) The Parties have therefore agreed to enter into this Agreement.

1. SERVICES

- 1.1. To achieve the Objective of the Incubatee, SGIARC-TBI agrees to provide its incubator facility to the Incubatee, which shall be utilized by the Incubatee.

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE INCUBATEE

Incubatee shall have the following obligations:

- 2.1.1. Incubatee shall submit a business plan stating the novelty of the technology/idea, business prospects, including demand and supply, need for Incubatee expertise, etc;
- 2.1.2. Incubatee shall incorporate the expression "**Supported by SGIARC-TBI, Shegaon**" (along with SGIARC-TBI logo) and any other expression as communicated by SGIARC-TBI in mutual agreement with Incubatee from time to time on their website;

- 2.1.3. Protection of the business information, plans, ideas or technology is the responsibility of the Incubatee. If any of the protected /confidential information needs to be disclosed to the SGIARC-TBI or other entity at SGIARC-TBI, the same should be shared after signing the Non-Discloser Agreement (NDA) by all the parties involved in such sharing.

3. OBLIGATIONS OF SGIARC-TBI

- 3.1. **SGIARC-TBI** shall provide the necessary resources as agreed in writing to the incubatee.
3.2. SGIARC-TBI will not enter into direct business of the incubatee, and therefore will not be held accountable for any business-related obligations.
3.3. Nothing in this Agreement creates any kind of business obligation for either Party except that SGIARC-TBI will provide the agreed resources to the Incubatee.

4. LICENSE OF THE PREMISES

Incubatee shall be provided with cubicle space (**Premises**) within the SGIARC-TBI building (**License**). The facility is equipped with AC, chairs and network line, and a desktop. Detailed specifications can be provided by SGIARC-TBI.

4.1. Use and Return of Premise:

- 4.1.1. Incubatee shall occupy and use the Premises for its business & business development activities, with the written consent of SGIARC-TBI. Incubatee agrees that it shall observe and comply with all laws, orders, rules, and regulations of any authority relating to the Premises, and will not permit the same to be used for illegal purposes nor permit any nuisance to be created or maintained thereon. Incubatee shall, at the termination of this License, return the possession of the Premises to SGIARC-TBI in the same condition as when possession was taken, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

- 4.1.2. Incubatee shall not permit any objectionable noise or another kind of pollution to escape or be emitted from the Premises or do anything or permit anything to be done upon the Premises which might tend to create a nuisance or tend to disturb any tenant in the said building or the occupants of neighbouring properties.

- 4.1.3. **SGIARC-TBI** shall not be responsible for any physical data and office equipment of the start-up for any damage or unforeseen conditions.

4.2. Alterations:

Incubatee shall make no alterations in, or additions to, the Premises without first obtaining SGIARC-TBI's written consent, and all erections, additions, and improvements made in or upon the Premises, either by Incubatee or SGIARC-TBI, shall be SGIARC-TBI's sole property, and shall remain upon Premises at the termination of this License, without compensation to the Incubatee.

4.3. Assignment:

- 4.3.1. Incubatee shall not assign this License or any interest hereunder and shall not permit any assignment at law, shall not sublet the Premises or any part thereof, and shall not permit the use of the Premises by any party other than Incubatee's agents without first obtaining the written consent of the SGIARC-TBI.

- 4.3.2. SGIARC-TBI shall not be liable for any damage either to any person or property, sustained by or due to the building or any part thereof, or any appurtenances thereof becoming out of repair or due to the happenings or any accidents in the said building, or due to any act of neglect of

any tenant or occupant of said building, or of any other person. This provision shall apply especially (but not exclusively) to damage caused by water, steam, sewerage, or bursting or leaking of pipes and shall apply equally whether such damage is caused by the act or neglect of other tenants or of any other person. If any such damage shall be caused by the act or neglect of the Incubatee, SGIARC-TBI may at its option, repair such damage whether caused to the building or to tenants thereof and Incubatee shall thereupon reimburse SGIARC-TBI the total cost of such damage both to the building and to the tenants thereof.

- 4.3.3. Incubatee agrees that all property upon the Premises shall be at the risk of the Incubatee only and that SGIARC-TBI shall not be liable for any damage thereto or theft thereof. SGIARC-TBI shall not be liable for the stoppage or interruption of water, light, heat, strike, or accident, over which SGIARC-TBI has no control.

- 4.4. **Signage:** Incubatee shall not be permitted to paint, place, erect or cause to be painted, placed or erected, signs on the front, back and side portions of the building or on the grounds surrounding the Premises without first obtaining written consent from the SGIARC-TBI. At or prior to the termination of this agreement the Incubatee shall remove any signs so painted, placed or erected, and shall restore the walls and other portions of the Premises to which any of the said signs were attached to their original condition, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

4.5. **Default:**

- 4.5.1. SGIARC-TBI reserves the right to terminate this agreement by a 3 (three) months' notice to the Incubatee whereupon this License shall end. Accordingly, the Incubatee will surrender possession of the Premises to SGIARC-TBI and remove all effects therefrom. However, SGIARC-TBI agrees that such a unilateral termination shall not be made before expiry of a period of 12 (twelve) months from the date of this agreement.

- 4.5.2. SGIARC-TBI may forthwith re-enter the Premises and repossess and remove all persons and effects therefrom without being guilty of trespass, forcible entry, detainer or other tort.

5. **Common Infrastructure**

SGIARC-TBI provides a common pool of hard and soft infrastructure to be shared by all incubatees. Certain resources can be provided on a per charge basis by SGIARC-TBI on request of Incubatee and subject to applicable rules and norms in this regard.

6. **Institute Infrastructure**

SGIARC-TBI will facilitate access to college infrastructure upon request of the Incubatee as per applicable norms in this regard. The facility will remain under the overall control of SGIARC-TBI and will be available to the Incubatee only for specific activities, as requested by the Incubatee.

7. **Services of Professional**

SGIARC-TBI may identify and associate professionals for accounting, IP, Legal and management expertise on a part-time basis. Incubatees can avail of their services on prescribed charges. Any direct services provided to the Incubatee would be paid for by the Incubatee to the service provider on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

8. **CONSIDERATION**

- 8.1.1. Allotment of rooms at SGIARC-TBI building will include the wi-fi, facility, electricity, AC, desktop, office chairs and cupboard etc.

8.1.2. If SGIARC-TBI decides to provide seed fund support to the Incubatee under this Agreement, it will be governed by the separate seed fund agreement.

8.1.3. If the Incubatee requires equipment and lab facilities from the college, they have to follow as per norms/rates decided by SGIARC-TBI, which shall include the cost of consumables in the equipment and instruments.

9. GRADUATION GUIDELINES FROM SGIARC-TBI

Incubatee shall be allowed to exit or shall be asked to exit by SGIARC-TBI upon the happening of one or more of the following events:

9.1.1. Underperformance by the Incubatee, for which the criteria shall be decided and applied by SGIARC-TBI on case to case basis.

10. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES


Incubatee hereby represents and warrants that:

10.1. This Agreement has been duly executed and delivered by its duly authorized representatives and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation on it, enforceable against it in accordance with the terms of this Agreement;

10.2. It is free to enter into this Agreement and fulfil and perform its obligations contemplated by this Agreement;

10.3. It owns and has a clear and unencumbered Intellectual Property Rights;
For the purpose of this Clause, **Intellectual Property Rights** shall mean any and all worldwide industrial and intellectual property rights and all rights associated therewith, including all patents and applications thereof and all reissues, divisions, renewals, extensions, provisional, continuations and continuations-in-part thereof, all inventions (whether patentable or not), invention disclosures, improvements, trade secrets, proprietary information, know how, technology, technical data, proprietary processes and formulae, algorithms, specifications, customer lists and supplier lists, all industrial designs and any registrations and applications therefore, all trade names, logos, common law trademarks and service marks, trademark and service mark registrations and applications therefore, Internet domain names, Internet and World Wide Web URLs or addresses, all copyrights, copyright registrations and applications thereof, and all other rights corresponding thereto, all mask works, mask work registrations and applications thereof, and any equivalent or similar rights in semiconductor masks, layouts, architectures or topology, all computer software, including all source code, object code, firmware, development tools, files, records and data, all schematics, net lists, test methodologies, test vectors, emulation and simulation tools and reports, hardware development tools, and all rights in prototypes, breadboards and other devices, all databases and data collections and all rights therein, all moral and economic rights of authors and inventors, however denominated, and any similar or equivalent rights to any of the foregoing, and all tangible embodiments of the foregoing.

10.4. It has requisite valid statutory licenses/permissions for its business; and

11. INDEMNITY

12. TERM AND TERMINATION

At the end of tenure of 18 months, SGIARC-TBI will evaluate the progress of the Incubatee and will decide the whether the Incubatee will continue in the SGIARC-TBI as an active incubatee or not.
- 12.2. TerminationEvents:
 - a) The Parties may terminate this Agreement by mutual consent.
 - b) The Agreement may be terminated by SGIARC-TBI or at any time by the Incubatee by giving 3 months' prior notice to the other Party.
- 12.3. The termination of this Agreement shall not in any way affect or prejudice any right accrued to any Party against the other Party, prior to such termination.

13. GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

- 13.1. This Agreement and any dispute between the Parties arising out of or in connection with it or any dealings between the Parties, whether contractual or otherwise, will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India (**Applicable Law**) and subject to Clause 13.2 to 13.4 below. The courts at Shegaon shall have exclusive jurisdiction to entertain any Dispute arising out of this Agreement.
- 13.2. In the event of any dispute, controversy or difference between the Parties arising out of or relating to this Agreement (**Dispute**), the representatives of the Parties shall, within ten (10)

13.3. If the Dispute is not resolved within twenty (20) days after the delivery of a Dispute Notice, whether or not a Dispute Meeting has been held, any Party to the Dispute shall be entitled to refer the Dispute to arbitration.

The arbitration proceedings shall be in the English language.

14.1. **Severability:** If any provision of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable as against any person, Party or under certain circumstances, the remainder thereof, and the applicability of such provision to other persons, Parties or circumstances shall not be affected thereby. Each provision of this Agreement shall, except as otherwise herein provided, be valid and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by the Applicable Law.

14.2. **Waiver:** The failure of either Party at any time to require performance by the other Party of any provision hereof shall in no way affect the right to require such performance at any time thereafter. Nor shall the waiver by either Party of a breach of any provision hereof be a waiver of any succeeding breach of such provision or be a waiver of the provision itself. No waiver shall be effective unless in writing signed by both the Parties hereto.





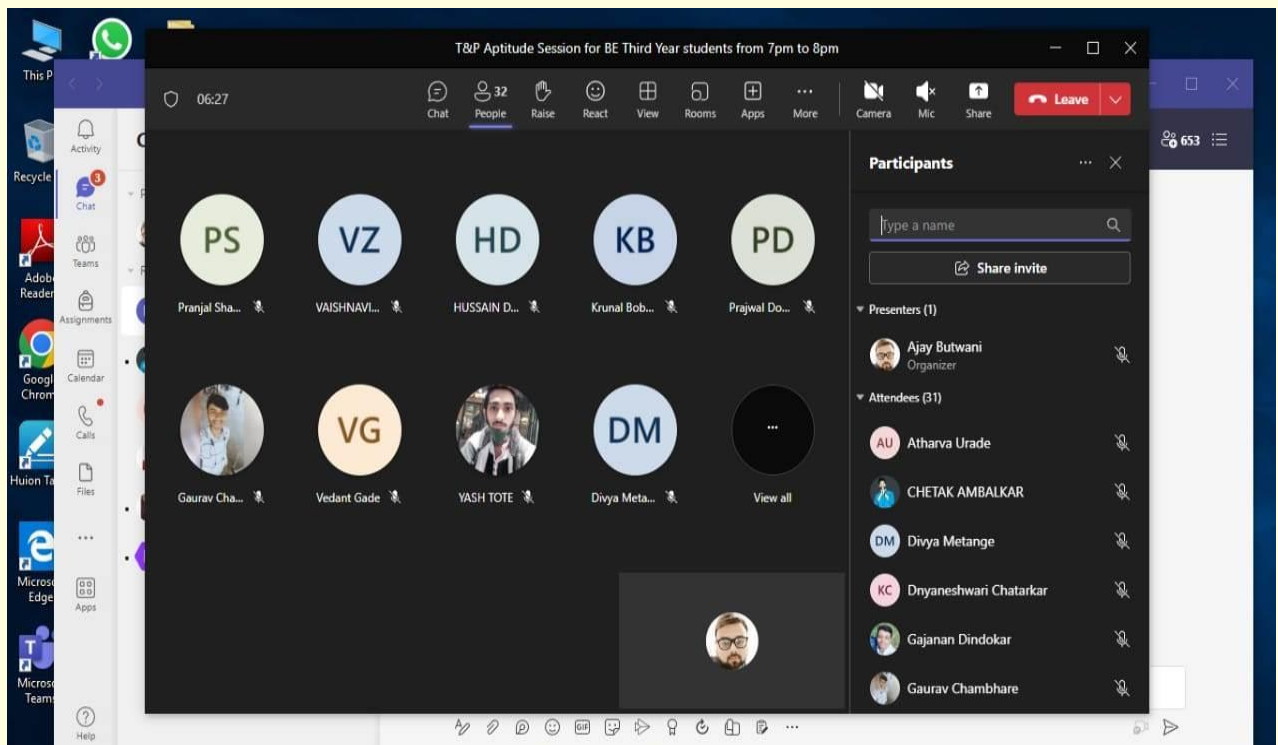

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This **Memorandum of Understanding** (herein after called the 'MOU') is entered into on this the 27th day of December Month 2022 (Date 27-12-2022), by and between **ExcelR Solutions**,

And

Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering (SSGMCE), Shegaon, MH

(Here after referred to as '**Second Party**')
(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

8. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the second party on various trending technologies.
9. ExcelR would be the training delivery partner for the student internships of a second party on various trending technologies of a minimum of four weeks duration.
10. ExcelR will reach out to students to communicate about course details, webinars, blogs, industry events, etc., which will be informative or promotional in nature.
11. Training & Development and dissemination of knowledge for students of second party & affiliated colleges and employees of both organizations.
12. ExcelR would work with incubation centers/ innovation cells of the second party (Case to a case basis), to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party

13. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to any other area that may benefit both organizations

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

14. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close cooperation would greatly benefit the student community and enhance their skills and knowledge.
15. Software Technologies Training: The first party will provide the training to the students and Faculties of the second party on different technologies like Data Science, Data Analyst, Artificial Intelligence, Tableau, Python, etc., Research and Development
16. Skill Development Programs: First Party trains the students of the second Party on emerging technologies to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
17. Guest Lectures: First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and in-house requirements.
18. Faculty Development Programs: First Party to train the faculties of the second Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in the concerned sector, if available.
19. Both Parties are to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
20. There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party to enroll the students and faculties for the different free pieces of training run by the first party under Everyday Learning Initiation.
21. The First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, Free certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of the second party and at the discretion of the first party.
22. In case, the second party wants to conduct customized commercial training then this agreement can be amended/added annexure with mutually agreed terms.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

23. The first party will have the sole rights to the curriculum and related content provided in the training and it cannot be replicated or copied without the consent of the first party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

25. The period of the agreement is valid for a period of 2 years from the date of signing of this agreement
26. This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU could be dissolved or canceled by either party at any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature. should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon it, the MOU loses its validity.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

27. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, pledge the other Party's credit, or extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

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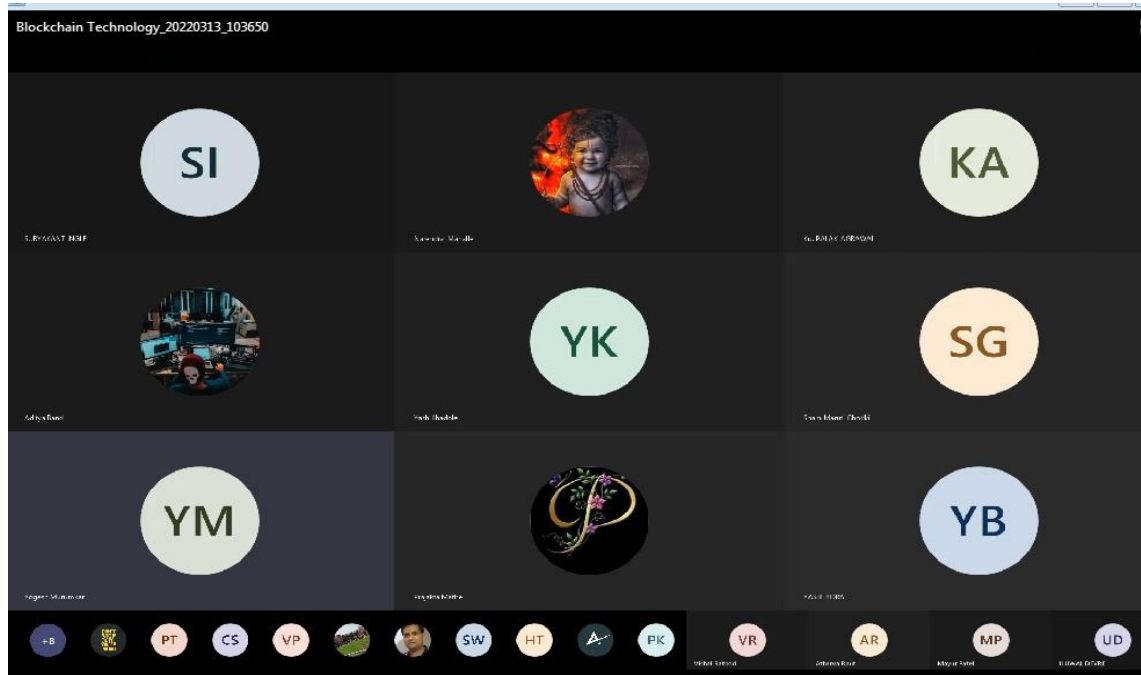

- (v) "Contract Years" means a period of 60 (Sixty) months commencing from the Commencement date.
- (vi) "Contract Period" means period for which contract has been executed
- (vii) "Force Majeure" means any event which is outside the reasonable control of the Party affected by such event impairing such Party's ability to perform any of its obligations (other than payment obligations) under this MOU, including, but not limited to Acts of God, fire, flood, lightning, war, revolution, act of terrorism, riot or civil commotion, epidemic, quarantine, governmental orders, prohibition, embargo, legislations, ordinances & enactments, notifications, rules and regulations, strikes, lock-outs or other industrial action, whether of the affected party's own employees or others, failure of supplies of power, fuel, transport, equipment, raw materials or other goods or services or loss of data;
- (viii) "Parties" means collectively ISIEINDIA and SSGMCE.
- (ix) "Party" means either ISIEINDIA or SSGMCE.
- (x) "Services" means the Scope of Work set out in this MOU.
- (xi) "Service Levels" means the service levels set out in this MOU.
- (xii) Industry Partner: Are those who is supporting this initiative to Skill and Employability for youth of India.
- (xiii) "Years" means a period of Sixty months commencing on the Commencement Date and on each successive anniversary of the Commencement Date and ending on the day before each successive anniversary of the Commencement Date.
- (xiv) ISIEINDIA and SSGMCE represents that they have the authority to enter and sign this MOU. The individuals signing this MOU represent that they are authorized signatories.



ARTICLE 2

INTERPRETATION

In this MOU, unless the context thereof requires otherwise:

- 2.1 Reference to singular includes reference to the plural and vice versa.
- 2.2 Reference to any gender includes a reference to all genders.
- 2.3 The expressions "hereof", "herein" and similar expressions shall be construed as references to this MOU as a whole and not limited to the particular Article or provision in which the relevant expression appears.
- 2.4 Any reference to any MOU or document shall be construed as a reference to such MOU or document as the same may have been amended, varied, supplemented or notated in writing at the relevant time in accordance with the requirements of such MOU or document and if applicable, of this MOU with respect to such amendments;
- 2.5 Reference to any legislation or law or to any provision thereof shall include references to any such law as it may, after the date hereof, from time to time, be amended, supplemented or re-enacted, and any reference to a statutory provision shall include any subordinate legislation made from time to time under that provision;
- 2.6 References to recitals, sections, articles, paragraphs, annexure and schedules are references respectively to recitals, sections, Articles, paragraphs, annexure and schedules to this MOU
- 2.7 The words and phrases "other", "including" and "in particular" shall not limit the generality of any preceding words nor be construed as being limited to the same class as any preceding words where a wider construction is possible.
- 2.8 The word "will" shall be construed to have the same meaning and effect as the word "shall" and vice versa.
- 2.9 The terms and conditions contained in this MOU shall override any other documents executed between the Parties.




3.1.2 Roles & Responsibility of ISIE (First Party)

- d) To arrange the tools, machines, equipment's and all other necessities to conduct training programs i.e. Mechanical & Electrical Labs (As required apart from Centre of Excellence tools & equipment's).
- e) Maintenance cost of COE will be borne by SSGMCE / Profit Generation by **Extra courses (Refer Annexure-2).**
- f) To provide students for 6 Months/1 Year/2 Years/4 Years & QP's/Non-QP's programs.



- g) Will provide high speed internet or Wi-Fi, CCTV, projector, white board.
- h) Collection of Fees / Dues from their students will be responsibility of College/Institute.

4.1.2. ISIEINDIA will setting up the 3 Labs under the COE-EV.

- 2nd Phase – Till July 2022

- Other Training Programs, Summer Training Workshop and PIP : Offline


4.2.5. All the participants will access the course from www.isieindia.com (dedicated LMS). No extra hard/soft material will be provided by ISIEINDIA to any participants.

- 4.3.2. ISIEINDIA reserved the right of new product design & development, patent and publish without any restrictions and consent of SSGMCE.

4.3(b) For SSGMCE (Second Party)

- 4.3.3. SSGMCE will only utilize the COE – EV facility for research work (Non-Commercialized activity) after notify to ISIEINDIA.

4.3.4. Any kind of product design & development, patent, publish or Research if done by SSGMCE in collaboration with ISIEINDIA will be the joint IP of SSGMCE & ISIEINDIA.

4.3.5. During the research, product design & development publish and patent, the required things will be borne by SSGMCE and ISIEINDIA will provide the COE – EV facility to utilize for research work. (Cost of research, product development and patent will be borne by SSGMCE).

4.3.6. During the Utilization of COE for research and project, if any failure of machine, equipment, tool the repair and maintenance cost of the same will be borne by SSGMCE.

➤ Placement Criteria(Internship/OJT/Placement)

4.4(a) For ISIEINDIA (First Party)

4.4.1. ISIEINDIA will arrange 3 Automotive Manufacturing Industries and SMEV associate's member industries for Internship/OJT/Placement.

4.4.2. Package, Designation, department will be as per company requirements.

4.4.3. Interview can be schedule In-Campus, Out-Campus and Online Interview.

4.4.4. Apart from 3 Industries, if any eligible students are left with Internship/OJT/Placement; ISIEINDIA will provide opportunity in rest of the industries as per industry requirement.

4.4(b) For SSGMCE (Second Party)

4.4.5. SSGMCE will assure the attendance of their students more than 80% consistently through the course to eligible for Internship/OJT/Placement.

4.4.6. Need to score more than 70% in assignment, assessment and projects etc. to be eligible for Internship/OJT/Placement.

4.4.7. No prior re-appears/supplementary/compartments/backlogs exams pending at the time of Interview.

4.4.8. Eligible students get the chance for interview in 3 companies (if they get placed in 1st or 2nd, they will not get the chance in next one).

4.4.9. If the student got offer letter from any industry, they will count as placed, no another opportunity he will get if he refuse to join by any reason.

(a) All the Parties shall keep confidential the Confidential Information and all aspects including the terms and conditions of this MOU, and any subsequent contract, from all



third parties, including, without limitation, business, financial, technological and other proprietary information of the other Party. The "Confidential Information" shall mean all non-public information of the disclosing Party to which the receiving Parties shall gain access or which is available to the receiving Parties directly or indirectly, whether in writing, orally, graphically, visually or any other tangible, intangible or electronic form, including, without limitation, all documents, data bases, music, photos, videos and any other material either created by or made available to the receiving Parties in pursuance of completing their obligations under this MOU and all information relating to the business of the disclosing Party, whether past, present, or future, financial results and projections, costs and prices, details of customers, employees and consultants (past, present or prospective), technologies, technical and business strategies, marketing, pricing and other strategies, trade secrets, intellectual property rights, as well as any such information not generally known to third parties or received from others that the receiving Party is reasonably expected to treat as confidential, whether such information has been expressly designated as confidential or otherwise.

(b) That during this term of MOU and any subsequent extension of the same, and for a period of 5 years after the termination of this MOU and/or subsequent extension, all the Parties hereby agree.

- I. To protect such Confidential Information by using the same degree of care, but no less than a reasonable degree of care, as the recipient uses to protect its own information of a similar nature.
- II. Not to disclose or share any documents/videos/photos like: Syllabus of any courses/Financials included in COE-EV & Trainings/BOM/Image, audio or Videos of COE-EV or Equipment's and online classes in any format or any information relevant to this MOU with any third party/person/organization etc.
- III. Not to use, disclose or reproduce any Confidential Information of the other Party for purposes beyond this MOU other than for what the Information had been disclosed to the receiving party, except with the express written consent of the other party whose information was disclosed.
- IV. To restrict access to the Confidential Information of the other Parties to its employees and subcontractors having a need-to-know in order to perform either Party's obligations under this MOU.
- V. Confidential Information does not include information that (A) was in the recipient's possession before receipt from the discloser; (B) is or comes into the public domain through no fault of the recipient; (C) is rightfully received in bona fides by the recipient from a third party without any breach of any duty of confidence; or (D) is disclosed under operation of law.
- VI. Either Party may disclose Confidential Information only where it is (i) required by Applicable Law; (ii) required by any Government Authority; (iii) disclosed only to professional advisers, directors, employees of a Party in connection with this MOU; (iv) or which has entered into public domain through no fault of that Party.



ARTICLE 7


7. GOVERNING LAW & DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 7.1 This MOU, its performance and any dispute or Claim arising out of or in connection with it shall be governed by and construed in all respects in accordance with the laws of India.
- 7.2 In case any dispute arises between the Parties with respect to the MOU, including its validity, interpretation, implementation or alleged material breach of any of its provisions or regarding a question, including the questions as to whether the termination of this MOU by one Party hereto has been legitimate, all the Parties hereto shall endeavor to settle such dispute amicably. If the Parties fail to bring about an amicable settlement within a period of 15 Days, either Party to the dispute may give 10 (ten) days' notice of invocation of the arbitration proceedings contained herein, to the other Party in writing. The Arbitration proceedings shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. This MOU will be subject to the jurisdiction of the Noida (U.P) Courts only.

ARTICLE 8

8. TERMINATION

- 8.1 Either Party may terminate this MOU post completion of the ongoing batches without payment of compensation or other damages caused to the other Parties, by giving notice in writing to the other Parties if any one or more of the following events happen:
- 8.1.1 Any Party commits a material breach of any of its obligations under this MOU which is incapable of remedy;
- 8.1.2 Any Party fails to remedy, where it is capable of remedy (save as to payment) after having been required in writing to remedy or desist from such breach within a period of thirty (30) days;
- 8.1.3 Any Party: (a) is adjudicated bankrupt; or (b) becomes insolvent or files any application for reconstruction or relief under any bankruptcy or insolvency law; or (c) goes into winding up, liquidation, receivership or trusteeship; and (d) makes a composition with its creditors or an assignment for the benefit of creditors or enters into any similar proceeding;
- 8.1.4 The other Party suspends or ceases to carry on its business.
- 8.2 The termination of this MOU shall be without prejudice to the rights and remedies of either Party which may have accrued up to the date of termination.
- 8.3 Any termination of this MOU (for whatever reason) shall not affect the coming into force or the continuance in force of any provision of this MOU which is expressly or by implication intended to come into or continue in force on or after such termination.
- 8.4 That this MOU may be terminated by either party giving one month notice in writing and at end of the time frame mentioned in the notice the MOU will stand terminated.

11.2 The rights and remedies of either Party in respect of this MOU shall not be diminished, waived or extinguished by the granting of any indulgence, forbearance or extension of time granted by such Party to the other or by any failure of, or delay by the said Party in ascertaining or exercising any such rights or remedies. The waiver by either Party of any breach of this MOU shall not prevent the subsequent enforcement of any subsequent breach of that provision and shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any subsequent breach of that or any other provision.

11.3 If any provision of this MOU is rendered void, illegal or unenforceable in any respect under any law, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby. Should any provision of this MOU be or become ineffective for reasons beyond the control of the Parties, the Parties shall use reasonable endeavors to agree upon a new provision, which shall as nearly as possible have the same commercial effect as the ineffective provision.

INCUBATION AGREEMENT

This Incubation Agreement (Agreement) is being executed in Shegaon, Maharashtra on this 18/07/2023 (Effective Date), by and between:

- (1) Agnipankh Energy Pvt. Ltd. (CIN-U36900MH2018PTC317271), a company incorporated and registered under the provisions of Indian laws, and having its registered office at post Datala, Tal. Malkapur, Dist. Buldhana, 443102, Maharashtra (hereinafter referred to as Incubatee, which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its administrators and successors in interest);

AND

- (2) **ShriGajanan Innovation and Advance Research Centre (SGIARC)-TBI Foundation, Shegaon**, a company incorporated and registered under section 8 under the provisions of Indian laws, having its registered office at Shegaon, in ShriSant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering Campus, Shegaon (hereinafter referred to as **(SGIARC-TBI)**, which expression shall, where the context so admits, mean and include its administrators, successors in interest).

Incubatee and SGIARC-TBI shall hereinafter individually be referred to as the **Party** and collectively as the **Parties**.

WHEREAS

- (A) The Incubatee is in the business of Electric Vehicle design, development and production in order to enhance the last mile connectivity.
- (B) **SGIARC-TBI** is a business incubator supported by Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj College of Engineering, Shegaon, that helps the Incubatees to overall growth including the office space for a specified period of time;
- (C) The Incubatee desires to retain the Services (*as provided under Clause 1*) of SGIARC-TBI, and the Incubatee has approached SGIARC-TBI for the facilitation of such coordination between SGIARC-TBI and the Incubatee, to which SGIARC-TBI has agreed; and

- (D) The Parties have therefore agreed to enter into this Agreement.

1. SERVICES

- 1.1. To achieve the Objective of the Incubatee, SGIARC-TBI agrees to provide its incubator facility to the Incubatee, which shall be utilized by the Incubatee.

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE INCUBATEE

Incubatee shall have the following obligations:

- 2.1.1. Incubatee shall submit a business plan stating the novelty of the technology/idea, business prospects, including demand and supply, need for Incubatee expertise, etc;
- 2.1.2. Incubatee shall incorporate the expression "**Supported by SGIARC-TBI, Shegaon**" (along with SGIARC-TBI logo) and any other expression as communicated by SGIARC-TBI in mutual agreement with Incubatee from time to time on their website;
- 2.1.3. Protection of the business information, plans, ideas or technology is the responsibility of the Incubatee. If any of the protected /confidential information needs to be disclosed to the SGIARC-TBI or other entity at SGIARC-TBI, the same should be shared after signing the Non-Discloser Agreement (NDA) by all the parties involved in such sharing.

3. OBLIGATIONS OF SGIARC-TBI

- 3.1. **SGIARC-TBI** shall provide the necessary resources as agreed in writing to the incubatee.
- 3.2. SGIARC-TBI will not enter into direct business of the incubatee, and therefore will not be held accountable for any business-related obligations.
- 3.3. Nothing in this Agreement creates any kind of business obligation for either Party except that SGIARC-TBI will provide the agreed resources to the Incubatee.

4. LICENSE OF THE PREMISES

Incubatee shall be provided with cubicle space (**Premises**) within the SGIARC-TBI building (**License**). The facility is equipped with AC, chairs and network line, and a desktop. Detailed specifications can be provided by SGIARC-TBI.

4.1. Use and Return of Premise:

4.1.1. Incubatee shall occupy and use the Premises for its business & business development activities, with the written consent of SGIARC-TBI. Incubatee agrees that it shall observe and comply with all laws, orders, rules, and regulations of any authority relating to the Premises, and will not permit the same to be used for illegal purposes nor permit any nuisance to be created or maintained thereon. Incubatee shall, at the termination of this License, return the possession of the Premises to SGIARC-TBI in the same condition as when possession was taken, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

4.1.2. Incubatee shall not permit any objectionable noise or another kind of pollution to escape or be emitted from the Premises or do anything or permit anything to be done upon the Premises which might tend to create a nuisance or tend to disturb any tenant in the said building or the occupants of neighbouring properties.

4.1.3. **SGIARC-TBI** shall not be responsible for any physical data and office equipment of the start-up for any damage or unforeseen conditions.

4.2. Alterations:

Incubatee shall make no alterations in, or additions to, the Premises without first obtaining SGIARC-TBI's written consent, and all erections, additions, and improvements made in or upon the Premises, either by Incubatee or SGIARC-TBI, shall be SGIARC-TBI's sole property, and shall remain upon Premises at the termination of this License, without compensation to the Incubatee.

4.3. Assignment:

4.3.1. Incubatee shall not assign this License or any interest hereunder and shall not permit any assignment at law, shall not sublet the Premises or any part thereof, and shall not permit the use of the Premises by any party other than Incubatee's agents without first obtaining the written consent of the SGIARC-TBI.

4.3.2. SGIARC-TBI shall not be liable for any damage either to any person or property, sustained by or due to the building or any part thereof, or any appurtenances thereof becoming out of repair or due to the happenings or any accidents in the said building, or due to any act of neglect of any tenant or occupant of said building, or of any other person. This provision shall apply especially (but not exclusively) to damage caused by water, steam, sewerage, or bursting or leaking of pipes and shall apply equally whether such damage is caused by the act or neglect of other tenants or of any other person. If any such damage shall be caused by the act or neglect of the Incubatee, SGIARC-TBI may at its option, repair such damage whether caused to the building or to tenants thereof and Incubatee shall thereupon reimburse SGIARC-TBI the total cost of such damage both to the building and to the tenants thereof.

4.3.3. Incubatee agrees that all property upon the Premises shall be at the risk of the Incubatee only and that SGIARC-TBI shall not be liable for any damage thereto or theft thereof. SGIARC-TBI shall not be liable for the stoppage or interruption of water, light, heat, strike, or accident, over which SGIARC-TBI has no control.

4.4. **Signage:** Incubatee shall not be permitted to paint, place, erect or cause to be painted, placed or erected, signs on the front, back and side portions of the building or on the grounds surrounding the Premises without first obtaining written consent from the SGIARC-TBI. At or prior to the termination of this agreement the Incubatee shall remove any signs so painted, placed or erected, and shall restore the walls and other portions of the Premises to which any of the said signs were attached to their original condition, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

4.5. **Default:**

4.5.1. SGIARC-TBI reserves the right to terminate this agreement by a 3 (three) months' notice to the Incubatee whereupon this License shall end. Accordingly, the Incubatee will surrender possession of the Premises to SGIARC-TBI and remove all effects therefrom. However, SGIARC-TBI agrees that such a unilateral termination shall not be made before expiry of a period of 12 (twelve) months from the date of this agreement.

4.5.2. SGIARC-TBI may forthwith re-enter the Premises and repossess and remove all persons and effects therefrom without being guilty of trespass, forcible entry, detainer or other tort.

5. **Common Infrastructure**

SGIARC-TBI provides a common pool of hard and soft infrastructure to be shared by all incubatees. Certain resources can be provided on a per charge basis by SGIARC-TBI on request of Incubatee and subject to applicable rules and norms in this regard.

6. **Institute Infrastructure**

SGIARC-TBI will facilitate access to college infrastructure upon request of the Incubatee as per applicable norms in this regard. The facility will remain under the overall control of SGIARC-TBI and will be available to the Incubatee only for specific activities, as requested by the Incubatee.

7. **Services of Professional**

SGIARC-TBI may identify and associate professionals for accounting, IP, Legal and management expertise on a part-time basis. Incubatees can avail of their services on prescribed charges. Any direct services provided to the Incubatee would be paid for by the Incubatee to the service provider on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

8. **CONSIDERATION**

8.1.1. Allotment of rooms atSGIARC-TBI building will include the wi-fi, facility, electricity, AC, desktop, office chairs and cupboard etc.

8.1.2. If SGIARC-TBIdecides to provide seed fund support to the Incubatee under this Agreement, it will be governed by the separate seed fund agreement.

8.1.3. If the Incubateerequires equipment and lab facilities from the college, they have to follow as per norms/rates decided by SGIARC-TBI, which shall include the cost of consumables in the equipment and instruments.

9. **GRADUATION GUIDELINES FROM SGIARC-TBI**

Incubatee shall be allowed to exit or shall be asked to exit by SGIARC-TBI upon the happening of one or more of the following events:

9.1.1. Underperformance by the Incubatee, for which the criteria shall be decided and applied by SGIARC-TBI on case to case basis.

10. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

Incubatee hereby represents and warrants that:

- 10.1. This Agreement has been duly executed and delivered by its duly authorized representatives and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation on it, enforceable against it in accordance with the terms of this Agreement;
- 10.2. It is free to enter into this Agreement and fulfil and perform its obligations contemplated by this Agreement;
- 10.3. It owns and has a clear and unencumbered Intellectual Property Rights;
For the purpose of this Clause, **Intellectual Property Rights** shall mean any and all worldwide industrial and intellectual property rights and all rights associated therewith, including all patents and applications thereof and all reissues, divisions, renewals, extensions, provisional, continuations and continuations-in-part thereof, all inventions (whether patentable or not), invention disclosures, improvements, trade secrets, proprietary information, know how, technology, technical data, proprietary processes and formulae, algorithms, specifications, customer lists and supplier lists, all industrial designs and any registrations and applications therefore, all trade names, logos, common law trademarks and service marks, trademark and service mark registrations and applications therefore, Internet domain names, Internet and World Wide Web URLs or addresses, all copyrights, copyright registrations and applications thereof, and all other rights corresponding thereto, all mask works, mask work registrations and applications thereof, and any equivalent or similar rights in semiconductor masks, layouts, architectures or topology, all computer software, including all source code, object code, firmware, development tools, files, records and data, all schematics, net lists, test methodologies, test vectors, emulation and simulation tools and reports, hardware development tools, and all rights in prototypes, breadboards and other devices, all databases and data collections and all rights therein, all moral and economic rights of authors and inventors, however denominated, and any similar or equivalent rights to any of the foregoing, and all tangible embodiments of the foregoing.
- 10.4. It has requisite valid statutory licenses/permissions for its business; and
- 10.5. It has not entered and will not enter into any other similar contractual commitment with any third party during the term of this agreement which will prevent or substantially impair the performance of its obligations under this Agreement.

11. INDEMNITY

Each Party (**Indemnifying Party**) hereby undertakes to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the other Party, its affiliates, officers, employees, agents, successors and assignees (collectively the **Indemnified Parties**) from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including court costs and reasonable fees and expenses of attorneys, expert witnesses and other professionals, arising out of or resulting from:

- 11.1. Any loss, damage or prejudice suffered by any of the Indemnified Parties due to the breach by the Indemnifying Party of any Applicable Law;
- 11.2. Any loss, damage or prejudice suffered by any of the Indemnified Parties due to any action of the Indemnifying Party resulting in a reputational loss to the Indemnified Party;
- 11.3. Any misrepresentation of any representation or warranty of the Indemnifying Party under this Agreement or any breach of the provisions of the Agreement by the Indemnifying Party;
- 11.4. The Indemnifying Party's failure to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement;

- 11.5. Anything done or omitted to be done through negligence, default or misconduct of the Indemnifying Party or of its partners, advisors, employees or agents;
- 11.6. Any claim of infringement of intellectual property rights by any third party; and
- 11.7. Any loss/ damage due to any statement defaming the Indemnified Party, its affiliates, sponsors, officers, directors, employees, agents, successors, assigns.

12. TERM AND TERMINATION

- 12.1. This Agreement shall be valid for a period of 18 months which can be further renewed for another 18 months at the discretion of SGIARC-TBI from the date of signing this agreement unless terminated by either Party as per the termination events mentioned below. At the end of tenure of 18 months, SGIARC-TBI will evaluate the progress of the Incubatee and will decide the whether the Incubatee will continue in the SGIARC-TBI as an active incubatee or not.
- 12.2. TerminationEvents:
 - a) The Parties may terminate this Agreement by mutual consent.
 - b) The Agreement may be terminated by SGIARC-TBI or at any time by the Incubatee by giving 3 months' prior notice to the other Party.
- 12.3. The termination of this Agreement shall not in any way affect or prejudice any right accrued to any Party against the other Party, prior to such termination.

13. GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

- 13.1. This Agreement and any dispute between the Parties arising out of or in connection with it or any dealings between the Parties, whether contractual or otherwise, will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India (**Applicable Law**) and subject to Clause 13.2 to 13.4 below. The courts at **Shegaon** shall have exclusive jurisdiction to entertain any Dispute arising out of this Agreement.
- 13.2. In the event of any dispute, controversy or difference between the Parties arising out of or relating to this Agreement (**Dispute**), the representatives of the Parties shall, within ten (10) days of delivery of a written notice from either Party to the other Party (**Dispute Notice**) hold a meeting (**Dispute Meeting**) in an effort to resolve the Dispute in good faith.
- 13.3. If the Dispute is not resolved within twenty (20) days after the delivery of a Dispute Notice, whether or not a Dispute Meeting has been held, any Party to the Dispute shall be entitled to refer the Dispute to arbitration.
- 13.4. If a Dispute is referred to arbitration by any Party, such Dispute shall be resolved by, and shall be finally settled by arbitration, by a single arbitrator to be appointed through mutual agreement of the Parties. If the parties fail to appoint an arbitrator within thirty (30) days after delivery of the notice of arbitration, such arbitrator shall be appointed in accordance with provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The seat of arbitration shall be in Shegaon. The arbitration proceedings shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof. The arbitration proceedings shall be in the English language.

14. MISCELLANEOUS:

- 14.1. **Severability:** If any provision of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable as against any person, Party or under certain circumstances, the remainder thereof, and the applicability of such provision to other persons, Parties or circumstances shall not be affected thereby. Each provision of this Agreement shall, except as otherwise herein provided, be valid and enforced to the fullest extent permitted by the Applicable Law.
- 14.2. **Waiver:** The failure of either Party at any time to require performance by the other Party of any provision hereof shall in no way affect the right to require such performance at any time

thereafter. Nor shall the waiver by either Party of a breach of any provision hereof be a waiver of any succeeding breach of such provision or be a waiver of the provision itself. No waiver shall be effective unless in writing signed by both the Parties hereto.

- 14.3. **Costs:** Save as expressly otherwise provided in this Agreement, each of the Parties hereto shall bear its own legal, accountancy and other costs, charges and expenses connected with the negotiation, preparation of this Agreement.
- 14.4. **Amendments:** No modification, addition or addendum to this Agreement shall be effective unless agreed to in writing by each of the Parties hereto.
- 14.5. **Assignment:** Neither Party shall assign or purport to assign any of its rights or interests under this Agreement to any other person or entity.
- 14.6. **No implied terms:** The Parties acknowledge and agree that neither of them has made any representation with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement or any representations inducing the execution and delivery hereof, except as specifically set forth herein and each of the Parties acknowledges that it has relied on its own judgment in entering into the same.
- 14.7. The Parties hereto, agree that, during the Term of this Agreement and at all times thereafter, they will treat as confidential and, except as required in the performance of their duties and responsibilities under this Agreement, not disclose, publish or otherwise make available to the public or to any individual, firm or corporation any confidential material, information, business plans, etc. shared between the parties hereto.

(herein after referred to as “**Second Party**”,

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as ‘**Parties**’
and individually as ‘**Party**’)

WHEREAS:

1. First Party is an Education company: BASE Education, Jalgaon
2. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide them with enhanced opportunities.
3. The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Aptitude Skill Based Training.
4. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL
PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO
AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

5. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and cooperation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings.
6. First Party and Second Party cooperation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to the second party in developing Aptitude training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the student's placement in industry.
7. The general terms of cooperation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding of the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties.
8. BASE Education would be the training delivery partner for the second party on various trending aptitude trainings and the tests.
9. BASE Education would be a training delivery partners for engineering students of Second party various trending aptitude trainings and the tests for minimum of 11 months in one academic year (Usually Commence from July to May).
10. Aptitude Preparatory Classes will be in hybrid mode format (Online + Off-line) as per need and availability.
11. Cooperation between both parties would be extended to placement assistance which may be mutually beneficial to both the organizations.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 12.The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would greatly benefit the student community and enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 13.Curriculum Design: First Party will give valuable inputs to the Second Party in aptitude training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 14.The content of training module will be designed as per the students level of understanding and with increasing difficulty as per the successive semesters.
- 15.The content of training module will be of minimum 50 hours per semester. Revision of content and teaching methodology will be done from the inputs from both the parties.
- 16.Both Parties are to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 17.First party would extend the help in providing artifacts such as training records, and certificates to the second party upon a written request from the second party. This information is limited to only the students of the second party and at the discretion of the first party.
- 18.In case, the second party wants to conduct customized commercial training then this agreement can be amended/adding an annexure with mutually agreed terms.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 19.Both the parties will have the sole rights to the curriculum and related content provided in the training.
- 20.Confidentiality: Except as may otherwise be required by law, each party will hold confidential, during and after the term of this Agreement, any confidential information disclosed to it or its representatives, and will not disclose any such confidential information to any third party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 21.The period agreement is valid for a period of 1 year from the date of signing of this agreement

22.This agreement will be valid only at the intentions of the parties involved therein, this MOU could be dissolved or canceled by either party at any time by giving 30 days' notice and shall not have any legal bindings in nature. should either or all the parties to it opt to not act upon it, the MOU loses its validity.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

23.It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

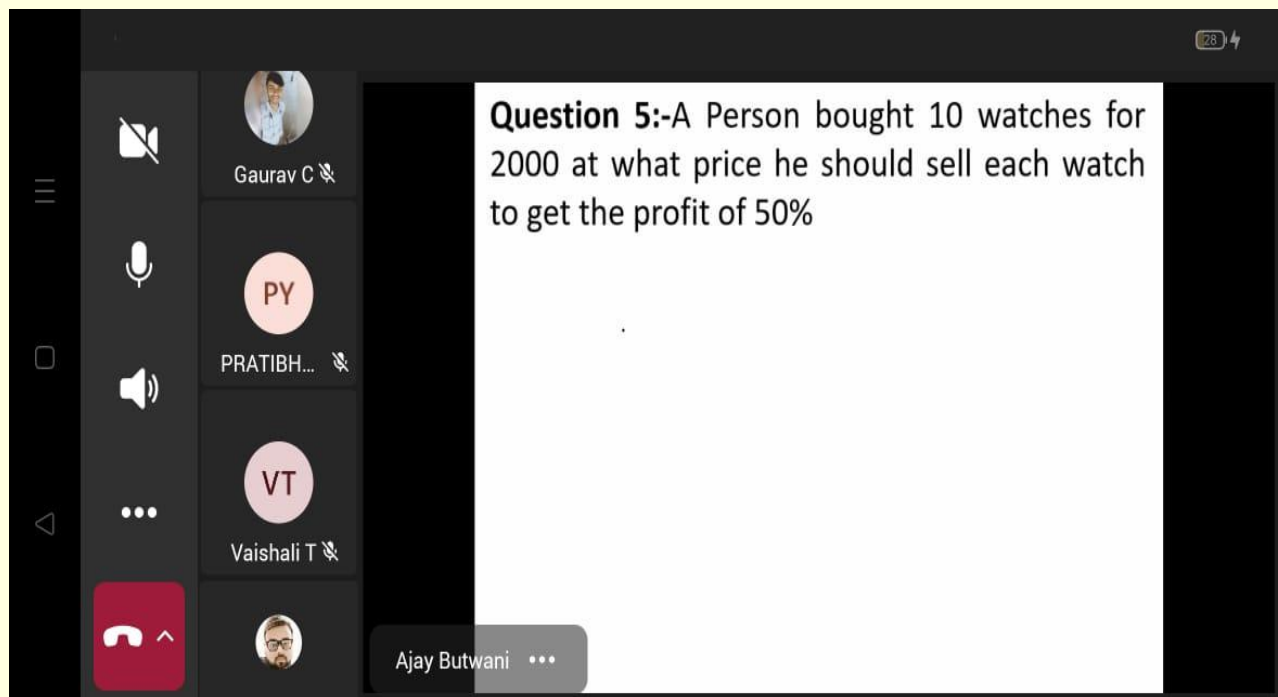
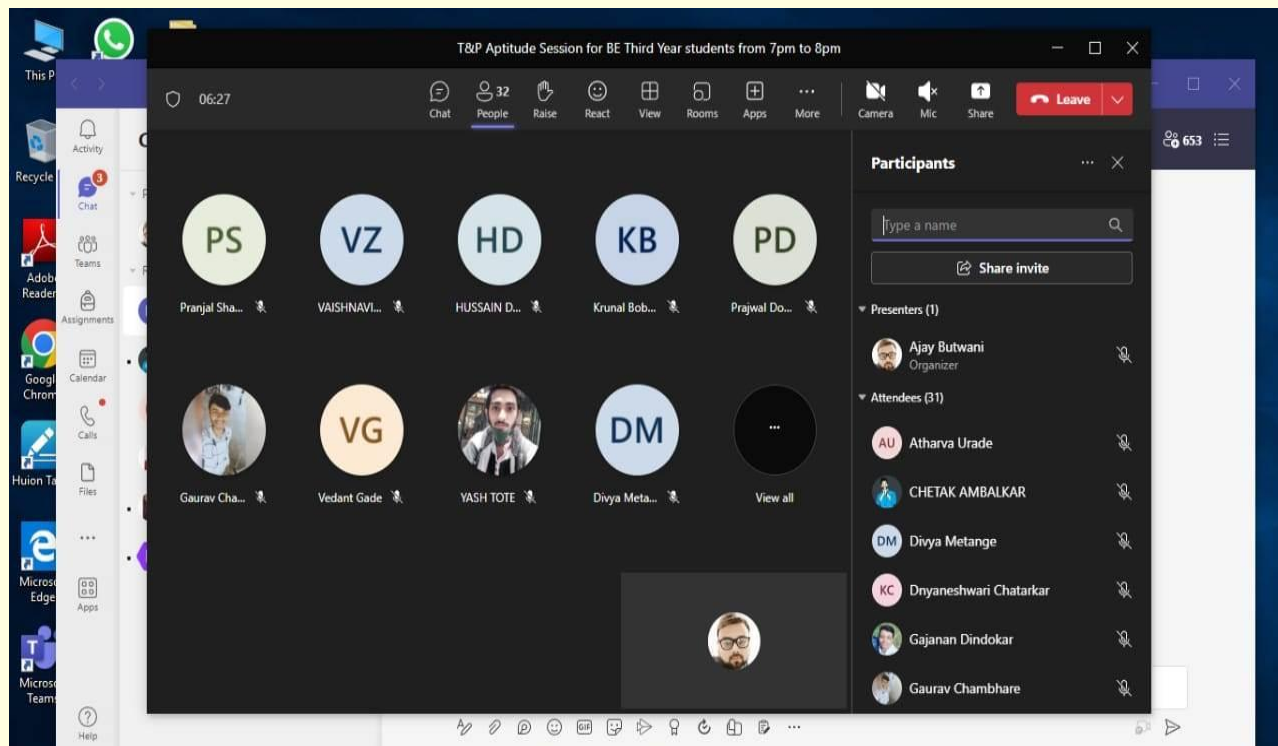
