Department of Electrical Engineering received a grant of two lakhs eighty-five thousand from All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi under AQIS scheme to conduct a series of online Short-Term Training Program (STTP) for faculty & research scholars of various institutes and organisations. The topic of STTP was Software Utility for Teaching and Research in Electrical Engineering.

Only the colleges with at least one NBA accredited course can apply for this scheme. The estimated cost as per AICTE is 110 lakhs. The duration of the project is two years.


