ANNUAL REPORT

The anti-ragging committee conducted comprehensive orientation sessions for all incoming students to familiarize them with the college's anti-ragging policies, rules, and regulations. During the Induction program, the chief warden delivered informative presentations highlighting the consequences of ragging, including legal penalties and disciplinary actions and also facilitated interactive discussions to promote awareness and encourage students to uphold a culture of mutual respect and dignity.

The committee displayed the anti-ragging posters outlining the anti-ragging policies and reporting procedures at prominent locations at the campus like canteen, hostel, administrative building. The contact numbers of all the members were provided for immediate assistance and support to victims or witnesses of ragging incidents.

The committee implemented regular patrols and surveillance measures in campus areas prone to ragging, including hostels, canteens, and recreational facilities and conducted surprise inspections and checks to ensure compliance with anti-ragging policies and regulations.

The chief Warden along with the wardens, counsellors and security personnel coordinated with students to reinforce the importance of collective responsibility in preventing and addressing instances of ragging. Regular evaluations and reviews of the action plan's implementation to ensure alignment with the college's objectives and goals were done periodically.

Due to the constant efforts and awareness drives, no case of ragging was reported during the academic year 2021-22. Throughout the academic year 2021-2022, the Anti-Ragging Committee remained dedicated to implementing these action plans with the aim of creating a safe, inclusive, and conducive learning environment.
